(Growing Readiness Opportunities and Work)</b> Open House Thursday, February 7 at 1:00 Garrard Education Center - 324 West Maple Ave.</p> <p>Kentucky, through the Kentucky Education and Workforce Development Cabinet, has awarded \$100 million in grants to 40 applicants. Garrard County Schools was awarded \$1,346,000. These funds are to blend resources that will expand career and technical education facilities and upgrade facilities/equipment in schools through local partnerships between private industry and educational institutions.</p> <p>Partnerships with Berea College, Campbellsville University, EKU, and BCTC will aid in expanding educational and career opportunities for high school students, out of school youth, as well as adults who wish to obtain their degree or specialized training such as EMT, and others. Currently there are three health science classrooms and three health science labs completed for daytime use by Garrard, Lincoln, and Boyle County high school students. Work is almost complete on the state-of-the-art computer labs that can be used for distance learning classes, computer classes, and more.</p> <p>The G.R.O.W. (Growing Readiness and Opportunities for Work) Academy will be a blended program where several classes will be provided (by various partners) at the Garrard Education Center, both during the daytime and evening. In addition to the classes, onsite child-care and dining services are planned. The community education program which is housed in the center, is currently partnering with other agencies to provide free workshops in real-estate, financial management, and insurance, which are held on Thursday evenings.</p> <p>Renovations are on-going at the Garrard Education Center to outfit it as a state-of-the-art work force skill development center. Multiple opportunities will be created for students and adults throughout Garrard, Lincoln, and surrounding counties. With an eye to the future, the G.R.O.W. Academy was developed to focus on providing opportunities for immediate expansion of work force development in this region as well as a venue for the continued expansion of vocational/career offerings.</p> <p>This project has a tremendous amount of support from close to 40 partners representing the private sector, secondary education, post-secondary education, as well as other community businesses and organizations. As the academy evolves and classes are developed, there will be additional opportunities for partnerships and perhaps even job shadowing/co-op opportunities for high school and college students.</p> <p>If you would like to learn more about the G.R.O.W. Academy, meet some of the current teachers and students, and learn ways you may be able to partner, please plan to attend the open-house on Thursday, February 7, at 1:00. The Garrard Education Center is located at 324 West Maple Ave., in Lancaster. If you are unable to attend on this date or would like to learn more about the G.R.O.W.
